In Namibia... The International University of Management (IUM) is a non-profit making organisation, with 4 campuses, and offers full and part time undergraduate programmes and MBA, IT and AIDS Management courses. They already have an IT lab in the capital city of Namibia, Windhoek, but urgently need to establish 3 others in additional regional centres in Namibia and expand the capacity in Windhoek.

- IUM has secure and established premises, where these IT labs would be housed. There is no risk of 'loss' of the equipment.
- IUM has a fully staffed and functioning IT department, with qualified teachers, so setting up the new labs would be no problem. They have already set one up, but desperately need more capacity.

Best of all we already have transport arranged to take the PCs, Servers, Screens and Printers to Namibia.

We have the volunteers to check and clean up the donated equipment and the facilities to store and pack them.
